munity in many ways, and due to our tremendous outreach efforts, IMANE is now known as one of the best organizations in the area. This was possible only with the help of a dedicated Executive Committee and a supportive Board of Trustees. I would like to extend a sincere and heart-felt thanks to both for helping me fulfill my vision for IMANE. It would not have been possible without their unconditional support.

For the very first time this year, IMANE teamed up with INDIA New England News for the first free Mega Health Expo. We had free health screenings and some of the leading physicians from the area educated the community about key health issues, especially those related to our community. It was an enormous success and the event was attended by more than 600 people. The IMANE initiative was also supported by most South Asian organizations from our area. India New England News also published a special supplement on IMANE, chronicling 35 years of IMANE history. The newspaper interviewed some of our founding members, leaders and some young physicians. It was also great to read about the 25th anniversary celebration of IMANE and the journey of our organization in the supplement.

IMANE also collaborated with Saheli, and helped raise \$56,000. Saheli is a great organization in New England that helps victims of domestic violence and their families. I can say once again with enormous pride that Saheli fund-raiser too was a incredibly successful event that not only raised funds for a great cause, but also increased awareness about a subject that remains a taboo in our community.

In addition, we also participated in a number of local programs who donated over \$2,000 to IMANE's charitable funds with which we were able to support not just the free health clinics that IMANE has supported for a long time but also some other clinics and charities that provide service to our community. We have built a bridge with almost every major local organization and charity in our community.

On the medical and continuing education front, IMANE hosted a great educational CME event in May at Massachusetts Medical Society (MMS) about risk management. The event was well attended and much appreciated by fellow members. Moreover, we continued to build relation-

ships with other medical organizations such as AAPI and MMS and Association of Physicians of Pakistani Origin of New England (APPNE).

IMANE events have also been a great place to meet with other physicians and their families on a social front. Our Youth Physicians/YPS has continued its outreach through hosting their events and we have had some great informal educations events with our Indian Women's Physicians Forum too. We also had valuable mentorship programs with Dr. Sanjiv Chopra for our young physicians.

Our membership has also continued to grow. Our efforts to keep our costs down and outreach efforts enabled us to get some supportive exhibitors, helping IMANE financially.

Salil K. Midha, MD, FACC

IMANE is pleased to present the 2013 Community Service Award to Dr. Salil Midha.

Dr. Midha just completed his 25th charitable mission in Africa where he provided cardiac care to patients who could not afford the life saving treatment. He implanted 9 single and dual chamber pacemakers in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, and also visited Kigali, Rwanda to begin coordinating patient care for future missions. In the last 12 months Dr. Midha has performed over 40 operations in Asuncion, Paraguay, Africa and in Meerut and New Delhi, India.



Dr. Midha is the President of Boston Cardiac Foundation (BCF), a non-profit organization that brings medical technologies and services to less developed countries around the world. The BCF team, made up of physicians, nurses, and technologists, performs cardiac procedures such as pacemaker surgery free of charge for patients in need. Members of the BCF team have been traveling around the globe on charitable missions for over 22 years. The BCF's motto is 'helping one heart at a time'.

Boston Cardiac Foundation team members have performed over 350 pacemaker implantations in India alone. The ability to perform these procedures is due to the support from communities in both the US and in India, as well as generous donations made by the major device companies: Medtronic, St. Jude Medical, and Biotronik. These companies have donated over 3 million dollars in equipment and supplies to sustain the BCF's charitable efforts around the globe.

Dr. Midha and his BCF colleagues were recently recognized for their efforts, earning a spot in the 2011 Limca Book of Records (the Indian equivalent to the Guinness Book of World Records). The team implanted the most charitable devices (11 pacemakers!) in one day. The 2013 mission to India was a very successful one. The BCF team saw over 60 patients in clinics at Sitaram Bhartiya Hospital in New Delhi and Jaswant Rai Speciality Hospital in Meerut, U.P.

Dr. Midha is Chief of Cardiology and Director of Cardiac Cath Lab, ICU and Cardiac Rehab program at Melrose Wakefield Hospital in Melrose, MA. Dr. Midha is Board Certified in Cardiology, Internal Medicine, Echocardiography and Nuclear Cardiology. In addition to his efforts to help the poor, Dr. Midha donates his time to help the local community with heart disease prevention by providing education and participating in local speaking events.



2013 Distinguished Physician Award – Dinesh Patel, MD

Dinesh G. Patel M.D. is Chief of Arthroscopic Surgery at Massachusetts General Hospital and is Associate Clinical Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at Harvard Medical School, Harvard University Boston. MGH and Sports medicine leadership established The Dinesh G. Patel M.D. Arthroscopy Learning Laboratory in June 14 2010.

Dr. Patel is a founding member of the Arthroscopy Association of North America and the International Association of Arthroscopy. www.Knee1.com. He has received many awards internationally for his pioneering work in Arthroscopic surgery.



In 2001, he established Asia's first Arthroscopic Psychomotor Skills Lab at BJMC /Paraplegia center in Ahmadabad. The lab is an example showing Partnership of the Public, Private, Multinational and Academic sectors, and serves to train Surgeons and students in India and Southeast Asia in Arthroscopic surgery. Dr. Patel has been in U.S. News and World reports as one of the best doctors in Orthopaedic surgery. In February 2002, Boston Magazine voted him by his peers as one of the top doctors in the field of Orthopaedics. He has been former member of Harvard medical school admission committee, current faculty member and Senior mentor for Harvard Medical School students.

He has served the citizens at large /public/physicians as both a member and Chairman of the Board of Registration in Medicine in Mass as well as a Board member of the Board of Directors and Executive Committees of the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB). In April 2003, the FSMB honored Dr. Patel with the John H. Clark, MD Leadership Award—the first from Mass state. —www.fsmb.org. In 2003, he was named Commissioner of the National Committee on Foreign Medical Education and Accreditation— Education dept.

He was one of the Founder and second President IMANE, Chair of CME and equipment donation committee for AAPI in 1989.

Dr. Patel was given the Vishwa Gurjari award in 1988. In Jan 2004, he was given a very prestigious Gujarat Garima Award by the Prime Minister of India in Ahmedabad. 

Brig. Gen. Reginald Edward Harry Dyer's[1] 45th infantry brigade marched Sound of army boots echoed off Jallianvala's walls so cracked and parched Within the walls 20,000 Indians gathered for a non-violent pact To implement ways to repeal an unjust Rowlatt Act[2]

British rifleman and two machine gun-armored cars blocked the garden 1650 bullet rounds fired on the gathering without a warning or pardon Ear shattering death cries and sight of the dying did not displease Dyer That 13th of April, 1919 innocent men, women and children had no savior




